### **Program**

The championship shall be decided by stroke play for girls and boys over three days with 18 holes being played per day.

16 <sup>th</sup> July	Practise day (reserve tee-times Phone: +43 (0)2865/8441)
17 <sup>th</sup> July	18 holes stroke play
18 <sup>th</sup> July	18 holes stroke play (CUT after 36 holes)
19 <sup>th</sup> July	18 holes final round

### **Conditions**

#### **Age groups U12, U14, U16, U18 and U21**

Stroke play for girls and boys over three days with 18 holes being played per day.

#### **Age Group U10**

Stroke play for girls and boys over two days (19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> July) with 18th holes being played per day.

The tournament is to be played in accordance to the Rules of the Golf of the R&A Rules Limited, the Conditions of Play of the Austrian Golf Association and such Local Rules as approved by the Championship Committee.

### **Eligibility**

288 players, girls and boys who are amateurs and members of an affiliated Austrian or foreign affiliated club and who have an exact handicap not exceeding:



### Handicap limits

U10	Boys: -36	Girls: -36
U12	Boys: -28,4	Girls: -28,4
U14	Boys: -26,4	Girls: -26,4
U16	Boys: -18,4	Girls: -26,4
U18	Boys: -11,4	Girls: -20,4
U21	Boys: -11,4	Girls: -20,4

If the field is not full at the closing date the Championship Committee reserves the right to change the player allocations and the handicap limits.

### Age groups

U10	born in 2010 and younger
U12	born in 2008 – 2009
U14	born in 2006 – 2007
U16	born in 2004 - 2005
U18	born in 2002 - 2003
U21	born in 1999 - 2001

### Breakdown

U10	Boys: 12	Girls: 6
U12	Boys: 24	Girls: 12
U14	Boys: 44	Girls: 18
U16	Boys: 51	Girls: 28
U18	Boys: 51	Girls: 18
U21	Boys: 33	Girls: 15

There will be a maximum of 96 foreign players allowed who are amateurs and members of an affiliated Austrian or foreign affiliated golf club and who have the above mentioned handicaps.

Should the group quota not be reached, the available places will be allotted to another age group. This decision will be taken by ÖGV Championship Committee.

### Cut

The cut will be determined by the number of players per group.

The formula used is: 45% of entries, rounded up the nearest number divisible by three plus ties.

i.e. 38 entries, 45% = 17,1 rounded up to 18 = 18 players and ties.

The number of players in the cut per age group will be announced after close of entries and will be available with the starting list.

45 % of Austrian Participants will make the cut in each age group (minimum 6 players).

### Entries

Entries have to be made generally online: Entry Forms ("Online Nenntool") on the website of the Austrian Golf Association <http://oegv.anmeldesystem.com>

In line with data protection guidelines, when entering an underage player to any Ögv tournament, it is mandatory to submit the signed parental consent form regarding the use of photographic material! For further information please read the Data Protection Ordinance.

### **Prizes**

#### **National Championship for Austrian players only:**

For all winners in all age groups Trophys/Medals for the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placed girls and boys.

**International Championship (including all national players):** Prizes for all winners in each age group, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placed girls and boys.

### **Course Rules**

To give all players the same opportunities it is forbidden for parents or trainers to accompany the flights (i.e. No forecaddies / on the fairways, no walking with flights). Parents, Friends, Professionals and others may watch from the distance but no advice may be given to the players. This rule does not apply to persons authorized by the committee. All decisions regarding the rules or other situations should be made ONLY by the players, authorized personal and referees. Parents or others who do not follow these rules could lead to the player's disqualification.

It is completely **forbidden** for parents, chaperones, trainers or anyone other than competitors, to play golf on the practice days.

**Caddies are not allowed!**

### **Buggys**

May not be used on the practice day. In the case of a Rules breach the Committee may impose a penalty of disqualification.

### **Committee**

The Committee will be nominated by the ÖGV Championship Committee.

Referees' decisions and the Committee's decisions are final. Local rules and start times will be displayed on the club notice board.

**The Committee reserves the right to amend the conditions of play before start of play.**

### **Data Protection Declaration**

The Championship Committee would like to make you aware that any photographs, videos and other articles covering the tournament may be used on the ÖGV website and shared on social media. By taking part in the tournament you agree to these conditions. It is mandatory to complete the signed parental consent form regarding the use of photographic material when entering any underage player to a tournament. Any entries received without uploading this signed form will be incomplete and not registered.
