Format

Stroke play over 3 × 18 holes without handicap, WHI-relevant, with a cut.
Counts toward the Austrian rankings 2026.

ÖGV ranking categorization: 10

Conditions of Play

Play is governed by the Official Rules of Golf (including the Rules on Amateur Status) of R&A Rules Limited, the current ÖGV Tournament Regulations (Hard Card), and any Local Rules approved by the respective Competition Committee.

For players with disabilities, Rule 25 applies.

For transgender persons, reference is made to the ÖGV Transgender Policy.

Tees

Men

Up to and including Mid-Am age category: Black
50+, 65+, 75+: White

Women

Up to and including Mid-Am age category: Blue
50+, 65+: Red

Eligible to participate

A total of 85 players may participate (excluding 5 wildcards*):

- Up to 35 professional golfers who are members of the PGA of Austria.
If there are more than 35 entries in this category, professional golfers will be excluded by the tournament committee according to the current national Order of Merit.
- Up to 23 professional golfers who are members of a recognized foreign PGA.
If there are more than 23 entries in this category, professional golfers will be excluded by the tournament committee based on the order of entry.
- Up to 27 amateurs (6 women, 21 men) who are members of a regular member club affiliated with the Austrian Golf Association (ÖGV) or a foreign association and have a maximum WHI of 4.0.

If entries exceed the allocated quota for amateurs, players with the highest WHI will be excluded by the Competition Committee. In the case of identical WHI, places will be decided by lot.

Players excluded due to exceeding quotas (professionals and amateurs) will be placed on a waiting list until registration closes and will replace players who withdraw or fail to register on time.

If the number of players in a group is not fully utilised, the remaining places will be reallocated to other age categories. This decision lies with the Competition Committee.

If the field is not full after the entry deadline, the Competition Committee may allocate starting places to players with a WHI higher than specified in the tournament announcement.

The ÖGV reserves the right to reduce the field for valid reasons (e.g., bad weather).


*Wildcards

The ÖGV reserves the right to allocate 5 wildcards, which will be awarded by the respective Competition Committee no later than 3 days after the closing date for entries.

Wildcards may only be granted to nominated and eligible players. Applications for a wildcard must be submitted by the closing date for entries to the ÖGV Tournament Coordinator, Thomas Schönberger, by email at thomas.schoenberger@golf.at.

Entries

Entries must generally be made (including for foreign players) via the online entry tool at <https://www.golf.at/turniere/oegv-turniere>. To register, please click on the GREEN BUTTON  next to the desired tournament.

Players who are not active members of an Austrian golf club need a user profile for the ÖGV MyGolf area in order to register for ÖGV tournaments. This can be created by registering at www.golf.at, by clicking on the RED BUTTON  at the top of the website.

To do this, you must provide an email address to which an automated registration link will be sent. The following information must be provided for registration and tournament entry for contact, tournament processing, and billing purposes: first and last name, email address, telephone number, nationality, date of birth, gender, WHI, home club, and billing address. You can then log in to the MyGolf area and register for ÖGV tournaments. <https://www.golf.at/mygolf/international-entries>

- Registrations by telephone, fax, email, etc. will not be accepted.
- a waiting list will be maintained.

Registration must be completed by Monday, October 05, 2026, at 12:00 noon at the club office or directly with the tournament director.

Entry fee

€ 230,-- per player (including practice round, fruit and granola bars on all tournament days, and a meal on one tournament day)

No discount for members of the host club.

Entry deadline

Wednesday, September 23, 2026, at 11:55 p.m.

Late entries

Late entries are possible up until Friday, October 02, 2026, at 12:00 noon, with an increased entry fee (+50%). Late entries must be submitted in writing to the ÖGV tournament coordinator Thomas Schönberger by email to thomas.schoenberger@golf.at.

Players who have registered by the regular registration deadline and are qualified based on the tournament announcement cannot lose their eligibility to participate due to late entries.

Format of Play and Cut Policy

Stroke play over 3 × 18 holes with cut.

Eligible for Round 3:

- Top 40 professional golfers plus all tied players based on the results after Round 2
- Top 20 amateurs plus all tied players based on the results after Round 2

The Competition Committee reserves the right to deviate from the cut policy.

Tournament Results

In the event of a tie for first place, the winner will be decided by a hole-by-hole playoff (sudden-death playoff, stroke play).

Prize money

The distribution of prize money will be announced prior to the tournament.

Open Ranking:
ÖGV Medals

- 1st–3rd place: women and men individually

Competition Committee

The ÖGV Championship Committee is responsible for appointing the competition committee and will announce this together with the referees, course rules, and tee times.

Decisions made by the competition committee are final.

Anti-doping regulations

By participating, athletes agree to comply with the currently valid anti-doping regulations of the Federal Anti-Doping Act as well as the anti-doping regulations of the ÖGV (especially the statutes, sports regulations, competition regulations) and the relevant international association.
