MPR G-11 Restriction on the Use of Green Maps Except for Amateurs Competing Exclusively in Pro-Am Competitions

During a round, a player may use only the yardage book(s) approved by the Committee. This restriction also applies to all other course maps, including records of hole positions.

Only approved materials may be used. These include:

- Yardage books approved by the Committee (effective January 1, 2022),
- Pin position sheets approved by the Committee, and
- Maps of the competition course no larger than a standard A4 sheet.

Players should note the additional guidance regarding Model Rule G-11 and the special provisions for handwritten notes.

Penalty for the first violation: Standard penalty

Penalty for the second violation: Disqualification

Practicing (Rule 5.2) Penalty for the first violation: Basic penalty (applies to the player's first hole)

Penalty for the second violation: Disqualification.

play a practice stroke on or near the green of the hole just completed, or not test the surface of the green by rubbing the green or rolling a ball

Stroke Play (Rule 5.2b) Players may not practice on the course on the day of a tournament before the round.

A player may also not practice on the tournament course between rounds.

Penalty for breach of the Local Rule:

Rule 5.2b is amended as follows in stroke play:

Between the play of two holes, a player must not

If the breach occurs between two holes, the penalty is incurred on the next hole.

The top 66 players and ties after the results of Round 2 qualify to participate in Round 3. The Competition Committee may determine a deviation from the cut rule.

SCORING: ELECTRONIC SCORECARD:

Use of Electronic Scorecard 1. Use of Electronic Scorecards: According to rule 3.3, the competition organizers can provide for (prescribe) the use of electronic scorecards. According to rule 3.3b/3, the player must inform the competition committee if there is an electronic or other defect and thus the player can also submit his score via a non-electronic scorecard.

In principle, the use of the electronic score card is binding. If a player has problems using it, he must contact the competition management and, if necessary, will be given a score card.
